We train *promotores*, or community health workers, to educate their own neighbors about issues like diabetes, healthy weight, breast health, domestic violence, and parenting. In 2015, we reached out to residents in laundromats, garages, churches, their homes and our own headquarters to combat serious public health problems faced by low-income families in Orange County, California.

Each of our programs offers a direct response to the needs of participants. They subsequently engage their neighbors and friends to change the underlying social conditions that give rise to these issues in the first place. These residents have built parks, changed land use policies, and created a health revolution. We hope you will join us in our mission for a healthier community.
